## Jackie Rowles, CRNA, MBA, MA, FAAPM

Jackie Rowles is a graduate from the Ball State University School of Nursing, and received a Masters Degree in Business Administration from Memphis State University. Her anesthesia certificate was earned at the Truman Medical Center School of Nurse Anesthesia, in Kansas City, Missouri, and was coupled with a Masters of Arts degree in Biology from the University of Missouri at Kansas City. Jackie's career path is quite diversified with experience in virtually every area of the Healthcare industry, including positions in: the clinical arena, hospital administration, marketing, and physician recruitment. She has been practicing in the pain management arena since November of 2002. Prior to that time, Jackie served for eight years as the Chief Anesthetist in OB Anesthesia for Community Health Network in Indianapolis, IN.

Jackie has been very active in the Indiana Association of Nurse Anesthetists (INANA) and the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists (AANA). She is the current President Elect of the AANA and will assume the position of President from August 2008 to August 2009. Jackie has previously served on the AANA Board of Directors as Vice President and Region 3 Director. Further AANA service includes: Chair of the AANA Public Relations Committee, Practice Committee, Administrative Management Committee, Liaison Committee for Excellence in Anesthesia, Nominating Committee, Task Force on the Institute of Medicine's report on Medical Errors and the Council of Accreditation's Task Force on Pain Management.

As a nationally recognized nurse anesthesia speaker, Jackie developed and directs an interventional pain management cadaver course for the Institute of Post Graduate Education (IPGE). Her professional leadership role reaches outside the AANA and includes membership on the Board of Directors of the American Academy of Pain Management (where she is credentialed as a Fellow in the Academy), the state of Indiana's Health Care Commission's Patient Safety Committee and Task Force in Office Surgery and Anesthesia (2003-2005), and the Anesthesia Task Force for the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (2000).
